The ure of ure in groin are agitated by a yellow discharge - The scab covering sore on penis is black in the middle and yellow around - The ulcer on surface of penis are rather enlarged - Says his ~~throat~~ <sup>throat</sup> is a little sore - ~~Left~~ at the angle of the right jaw - ~~Left~~ <sup>Mar. 11.</sup> (77)

The fungus tendency is decreasing. The testicle is larger than it was. The lips are turning in, in one point, and out, in another - The chord feels thicker - The director keeps with equal freedom into bend of testicle - I have passed a bougie into the bladder, & no remarkable pain or obstruction to be found - ~~Left~~ <sup>Acid.</sup> (77)

a reddish red round sore - hardness up - ~~Left~~ <sup>Acid.</sup> (8)

Thomas Lynch - V. 2 - p. 124  
The surface of ulcer round much. On the general surface. The rim or margin perpendicular - running up. ~~Left~~ <sup>Acid.</sup> (15)
