

which she refers to heart. Has never had
any venereal complaint - on the surface of
some of the tumours, there appears a
hole or holes like the orifice of the
sebaceous glands - into some of these a
hair can be introduced and turned in
little round. On the upper part of the
inner side of the left arm near the
axilla there is a soft, protruding nodule,
which appears to be divided by fissures
into a kind of lobulated texture - on the
surface of many of these lobules there
is the orifice of a sebaceous gland,
filled with sebaceous matter with a
black surface, which can be
squeezed out. This has not the ap-
pearance of an aggregate of the other
tumours - it is not painful, and is a
menstrual for its softness. Mr. Watson
removed one of the larger ones with a
knife - although he wished to cut it on
level with the skin, the knife failed
though it in such a way as to leave
a protruding nodule like the rest before
it was cut, but of a smaller size. This
was afterwards cut away by cauterizing it
with a hook - when the tumour was
examined it was found to be covered by
the skin, which appeared to be thrust
over the heart, although it was not stretched.
The contents of the tumour was a sub-
stance of a fleshy color, of the con-
sistence between cellulose & phloem tissue -
not homogeneous, but apparently ho-
mogeneous, & pieces combined together -
the surface of the sebaceous ducts were
enlarged - I saw this woman again in 4
days, and found a firm fungus protruding from
the surface, from which the tumour had been
cut flat - she said it was sore - it was soft
on the surface but firm - 135
