## ANNUAL REPORT.

*June, 1933.*—Mr. W. C. P. Smyly was unanimously re-elected Hon. Librarian.

*July, 1933.*—Some of the meetings in connection with the British Medical Association were held in the College. The last meeting of the British Medical Association held in this country was in the year 1887.

*July, 1933.*—Mary Louisa Prentice Montgomery Lecture-ship. A lecture was delivered by Lieut.-Col. Wright during the time the British Medical Association met in Dublin.

*July, 1933.*—The Honorary Fellowship of the College was conferred upon Professor Dean Lewis, President of the American Medical Association. Mr. William Doolin, F.R.C.S.I., gave the oration, in the absence of the Secretary.

*February, 1934.*—The College celebrated its 150th birthday. The Charter was granted in 1784.

The Council conferred the Honorary Fellowship upon Mr. William Ernest Miles, F.R.C.S., Surgeon Emeritus, Cancer Hospital, London, on the occasion of the Charter Day Dinner.

Sir Thomas Myles was appointed to represent the College at the meetings of the General Medical Council.

Mr. Richard Atkinson Stoney was re-appointed to represent the College at the meetings of the Saorstát Medical Council.

*February, 1934.*—The Council decided to divide the Chairs of Physiology and Chemistry and Physics. They advertised for a Professor of Chemistry and Physics, and out of many candidates Professor W. N. Rae was appointed.

Formal permission was given to a number of Societies to hold their meetings in the College, including that of the Association of the Royal College of Surgeons in Ireland, the British Medical Association, the Royal Zoological Society, the Irish Medical Association, the Irish Hospitals Trust, Ltd., Women's National Health Association.

## Museum.

GENTLEMEN,

There is little new to report from this department.

The Museum held its own in a most satisfactory way during the visit of the British Medical Association to Dublin last July. Over 100 specimens were exhibited in the Pathological Section, the exhibitions being held in the Anatomy Room, Trinity College.

The arrangement of the specimens was under the joint management of Prof. T. T. O'Farrell, Dr. Lait, and the Curator, and the Section was patronised by a large number of visitors.

Mounting of new specimens has been hampered during the session owing to the illness of Mr. George Wilmot, Senior Technician, and the work during the last two months has been carried on practically single-handed by Mr. C. O'Toole. His diligence has been admirable, and the work of cutting and mounting microscopic sections has never been better done.

The number of specimens used for class demonstrations by the Curator shows little variation from year to year, and amounts in the aggregate to about 100.


