ANNUAL REPORT.

July, 1937.—The Council appointed a sub-committee with powers to incur expenditure up to £300 in alterations to and the redecoration of the department of Physiology.

October, 1937.—Mr. R. Atkinson Stoney was elected to represent the College on the General Medical Council.

Dr. Pollock was appointed as Assistant to the Professor of Pathology.

November, 1937.—In the matter of the Francis Nolans prize the Council decided to give £40 in two moieties each year to the Doctor's son or daughter who obtains the highest marks in the Autumn Preliminary Examination after the new regulations come into force. The money to be paid in relief of fees.

The Council accepted with thanks the gift by Capt. J. R. Wilton of a portrait of the late Dr. Rawdon Macnamara.

January, 1938.—Lady Myles offered a presentation of books and a picture of Sir Donald MacAlister which was accepted with thanks.

February, 1938.—At a special Meeting Dr. T. Gillman Moorhead and Mr. R. Atkinson Stoney were nominated for the Seanad elections.

March, 1938.—The revised regulations for the Medical Curriculum were approved.

May, 1938.—The recommendations of the Education Committee for the rebuilding of the Chemistry Lecture Theatre and a new Biological Laboratory at a cost of £2,580 were approved.

Museum.

GENTLEMEN,

I have the honour to submit the following Report from the Museum.

A good deal of work has been done in the Museum during the year. The collection is steadily increasing in numbers and value year by year. The catalogue has been revised and enlarged as fresh specimens come in and the presses have been re-arranged and lighted so as to exhibit the contents to the best advantage. The interest and ingenuity shown by the Assistant Pathologist in the re-organisation have been of the greatest value and he has added a number of small lantern slide transparencies which illustrate many of the pathological conditions admirably.

Six new specimens have been mounted and are now in the cases, and there are about a dozen in course of preparation for mounting. Six others have been mounted.

It is impossible to say what number of specimens have been used for demonstration—they have been studied by the students, under supervision, almost daily throughout the session. Twenty specimens were borrowed by the examiners in Medicine, eight for Surgery and nine for clinical demonstration by Dr. Coolican. About 100 specimens are selected annually by the Curator for examinations in Pathology—here and in the Royal College of Physicians.

It is hoped that arrangements will be completed during the summer vacation for the transfer of some of the larger skeletons from the old museum to the care of the Professor of Zoology in Dublin University.
