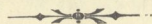

ANNUAL REPORT.

June, 1935.—The following were elected in connection with the Carmichael Prize Essay :—Mr. R. Atkinson Stoney, F.R.C.P.I.; Sir C. A. K. Ball, F.R.C.S.I.; Mr. William Doolin, F.R.C.S.I.

November, 1935.—An electro-cardiograph was presented to the College through the kindness of the Medical Board of Mercer's Hospital.

Report was read from the Examiners in connection with the Carmichael Prize Essay. In the report they recommended that the *nom de plume* of "Libra" be awarded the prize. On opening the envelope it was found that the writer of the essay was William R. Fearon. The prize was unanimously awarded to Dr. William R. Fearon.

Barker Anatomical Prize.—On the recommendation of the Examiners, it was decided to award the following prizes :—John Bunting, £26 5s. 0d.; J. Lazarus, £10 10s. 0d.; N. B. Symons, £10 10s. 0d.; T. E. Alexander, £10 10s. 0d.

December, 1935.—The Hospitals Trust, Ltd., presented the Athletic Association with a silver cup for annual competition in connection with the Schools' Sports.

February, 1936.—Sir Thomas Myles, F.R.C.S.I., was elected representative of the College at the meetings of the General Medical Council. Mr. R. Atkinson Stoney, F.R.C.S.I., was re-elected representative of the College at the meetings of the Saorstát Medical Council.

March, 1936.—A portrait of the late Mr. William Stoker, F.R.C.S.I., was presented to the College by his son, Major Stoker.

April, 1936.—The late Mrs. M. C. Nolans gave a legacy of £1,000, to be used by the College to found a scholarship in memory of her husband, the late Francis Nolans, F.R.C.S.I. The Council decided that the legacy left by the late Mrs. Nolans be utilised to found a yearly entrance scholarship for sons of General Practitioners, to be called the Francis Nolans Prize.

Museum.

GENTLEMEN,

Definite progress has been made during the year in the arrangement and cataloguing of the mounted specimens in the collection. Many new specimens have been added, a good many have been mounted, and others re-mounted, while a typed catalogue of the specimens in the cases has been put up in a prominent position for the use of students.

The collection has again come into favour for the purpose of examinations in Medicine and Surgery, and considerable use is made of it for tutorial and clinical teaching of these subjects.

As regards the Zoological specimens in the old Museum, steps have already been taken with a view (subject to the approval of the Council) to their transference to the School of Zoology in Trinity College. Many of them are rare, and of great zoological interest, and it is felt that it would be an advantage to have them removed to the only institution in this country where the subject is systematically taught. Professor Gatenby has already inspected some of them, and has expressed his readiness to house them, coupled with an acknowledgment of their source, and a promise of facilities for studying them to any student of this College at any time.

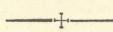
