REPORT

10th May, 1956.—The College agreed to co-operate with Trinity School of Physic in the appointment of clinical tutors in a number of hospitals.

The Council, on the recommendation of the adjudicators, made no award of the first prize for the Carmichael Essay but awarded a second prize to Dr. J. D. Llewellyn-Jones.

Dr. R. B. Dockrell was appointed representative on the General Dental Council.

11th October, 1956.—Mr. T. O. Graham reported to the Council on the recent improvements which had been carried out in the Library and in the formation of an additional lecture room and laboratory in the Schools.

A post-graduate lecture to be called the Abraham Colles Lecture has now been established.

Mr. R. Atkinson Stoney was appointed to be a member of the General Medical Council for a period of one year.

8th November, 1956.—It was decided not to institute a Diploma in Children's Dentistry.

14th February, 1957.—The Council gave its approval on the suggestion of the English College to the holding of a meeting in London in May to consider the establishment of an International Council of Surgical Colleges. Mr. F. Gail will represent the College at this meeting.

14th March, 1957.—Mr. Bouchier-Hayes informed the Council of the appointment of clinical tutors at Mercer's Hospital.

Mr. T. O. Graham was nominated for the Cultural and Educational Panel of the Senate.

REPORT OF THE LIBRARY

For year ending 5th April, 1957

The total number of books and periodicals borrowed by Fellows, Licentiates and students during the past year was 11,936. The usual periodicals were received, and books were acquired by purchase and donation.

During the summer vacation the Library was re-decorated, and matting laid on the passage ways between the tables so that readers enter and leave with minimum disturbance. A new room was fitted and furnished for the Librarian, and the room formerly occupied by him was converted into a reading-room for Fellows and Licentiates.

The following original communication by the Librarian was published in the *Irish Journal of Medical Science*, January 1957: A notable Irish Physician (Thomas Arthur, 1593-1675). He was invited on 16th March, 1957, to address the Blackrock Literary and Debating Society, the subject being Sir Thomas Molynceux, Bart, M.D. (1661-1733).
